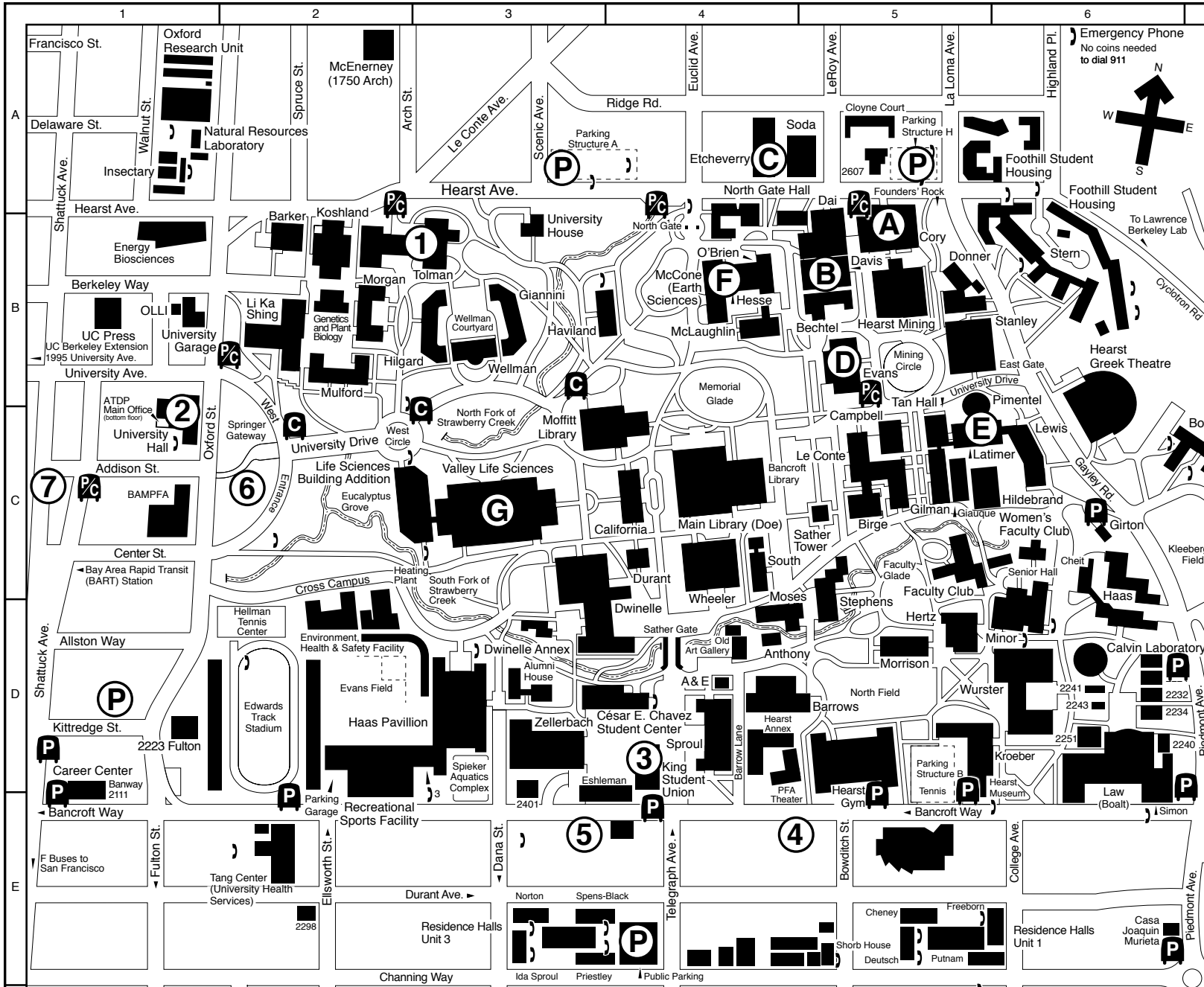

CARPOOL DIRECTORY

For those interested in forming carpools—whether to share a private vehicle or meet at a convenient BART station—registering for ATDP’s website will allow you to opt in to the carpool directory on a per-class basis. If you did not apply online, you will need to provide the student name, birthday, and ATDP student ID number (see your green Course Placement & Payment Notice) in order to access your records.

Visit atdp.berkeley.edu/enrollment and click on the “Carpool Info” button for each relevant enrollment. Follow the instructions and select your preferences to find matches based on your course’s schedule and meeting time. From the list at right, select the city or town nearest you.

The ATDP carpool directory is provided solely for your convenience, and it is up to you to make arrangements with other families listed in the directory. **By opting in to ATDP’s carpool directory, you agree to make your contact information available to other families using this service. ATDP is not liable for any circumstances resulting from the use of this information.** ATDP does not provide any other help or service in arranging for transportation to and from its program locations.

Based on demand, ATDP has moved from a hardcopy mailing to an online-only carpool directory. If you have questions or cannot access the carpool directory online, call the ATDP office for assistance.

BART

BART is a popular and convenient transportation option! The ATDP office in University Hall is just 500 feet from the Downtown Berkeley BART station. From there, Tolman Hall is a short walk across the northwest corner of campus. **Tip:** You can use our online carpool directory (see above) to find other students who want to meet at a nearby BART station and ride together. **Discount tickets:** BART only authorizes middle and high schools to resell discounted Orange tickets at half the price of a standard ticket. Because ATDP is not a middle or high school, we cannot sell these tickets. However, if a student is able to purchase these tickets at his or her own school, they may be used for transit to and from ATDP during the summer. BART Orange tickets do not expire and, if unused, may be returned to BART for a cash refund.

BEAR TRANSIT

The UC Berkeley Bear Transit shuttles make regular runs to stops across campus, which may be useful for students whose classroom location is further uphill (east). These stops are marked on the campus map (reverse). The Perimeter Line (marked “P”) circles the entire campus every half hour, and the Central Campus Line (marked “C”) runs through its middle; stops serviced by both lines are marked “P/C.” (Note: The C Line does not run during midday hours.) For those coming on public transit, there is a convenient stop near BART at Shattuck Square and Addison Street, in front of the Scandinavian Designs store. The shuttle is free for students who show their ATDP ID card; fare is \$1 for others. PARKING

Parking is **very** difficult near campus. Street parking in the areas surrounding the campus is restricted to two hours for non-residents. The campus student parking lots (“S” lots) are sometimes open to the public during weekdays in the summer—the policy varies each year. The Parking & Transportation Office has not yet determined the policy for summer 2016. The City of Berkeley also operates a garage on Durant Ave. between Dana and Telegraph, just south of the campus, though fees can add up after a few hours (see location on the map on the reverse side).

DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO UNIVERSITY HALL



University Hall’s street address is 2199 Addison, bordered by Addison St., Oxford St., and University Ave. Please be mindful of construction on nearby roads.

To UC Berkeley from **Interstate 80 North or South:** take the University Avenue exit and proceed eastward about 3 miles (toward the hills) until you reach the western edge of campus, at Oxford Street. University Hall is on your right. Turn right (heading south) onto Oxford and right again onto Addison Street to arrive at University Hall’s Addison Street entrance and street parking.

To UC Berkeley from **State Route 24 westbound:** take the Highway 13 North exit shortly after exiting the Caldecott Tunnel. Proceed along Highway 13 (it turns into Ashby Ave.) until you reach Shattuck Avenue. Turn right onto Shattuck (heading north) and proceed until you reach University Avenue. Turn right onto University Avenue (heading east), then right at Oxford, a block away. University Hall is on your right. Turn right again onto Addison Street to arrive at University Hall’s Addison Street entrance and street parking.

The contiguous campus is bordered by Hearst Avenue on the north, Oxford Street along the west, Gayley Road/Piedmont Avenue to the east, and Bancroft Avenue along the south.
